Advertisement Signs

There is one mesh sign currently hanging on field 5 as a "test" sign. So far it has weathered well, even during the high winds.

Complex Issues / Improvements

Lights – Three field lights fell from the posts due to high winds, each bulb alone costs \$150. The Association used to rent a boom truck for \$200 and Tim would fix the lights, the people that rented the Association the boom truck no longer have the truck. Jena contacted Lighting Maintenance and they came out and replaced burned out bulbs, repaired lights that fell and readjusted the lights. Each one is to be set to a certain degree, this has been done. Please keep your eyes open for any broken lights so we can get them repaired before they fall and hurt someone. Current repair bill for the lights is approximately \$3,000.

Water main break inside small concession stand – Lind Exco is currently repairing the water main under the small concession stand by fields 6-8.

Sprinkler systems – up and running, there are some breaks but they are being looked at.

Concrete – Due to all of the large equipment that has been at the complex repairing lights, installing playground equipment, and fixing water mains the concrete is cracking by the concession stand and around the playground equipment. It was recommended that we spray paint the cracks fluorescent orange to warn people to be careful. Guy will look into the cost of the paint. We do not have money in the budget to fix the concrete this year.

Fences – Fence Connection will fix the 1st and 3rd base fence lines and the dugout fences.

Donation / Memorial Wall – the Wall will be at the shelter by field 4.

Shelter Area – the Mills family is hoping to start soon on the shelter.

Small Concession Stand Windows – the Association is getting bids to replace the heavy wood doors at the small concession stand with brick and roll-up doors.

Restrooms – Children – We need ideas of how to keep the kids from vandalizing our restrooms. – Vince recommends posting signs; he will get the verbiage to Jena.

Scoreboards – They are up and running as of Monday, May 1, 2006.

Playground Equipment – A locator will be out next week to locate utilities so we can finish installing the benches, edging, etc. Anyone interested in helping, please contact Tim or Jena.

City Issues

Warm up areas were approved by the City – there will be a meeting with Jerry Cole on Friday, May 3, 2006 to process the paperwork. The warm-up areas will cost the Association approximately \$15,000. There is some grant money remaining so we may apply for funds to install handrails.
