City Issues

Grants – the last meeting with the City in regards to the grant applications went very well – we should have a response to our applications by the beginning of November.
PA System – The Board agreed to apply for additional grant money to have a PA system installed. Ken Beer from Modern Woodmen of America is interested in helping through a fundraiser; they will match up to \$2500. The PA system reviewed is a top of the line and includes a wireless microphone.

Handrails – The Board agreed to apply for additional grant monies to have handrails installed on all stairways; the estimate to complete this is \$12000.00 for all eight fields.
Sprinkler System clocks and water gauge – Again, the Board decided to apply for additional grant monies to have timers with rain gauges put on the watering system - these gauges prevent the water from coming on when there has been recent moisture.

Fall Projects

Front Entrance Water Main Break – In order to fix this water leak the concrete at the main entrance will have to be torn up, this work will begin after Midget Football is over for 2006.

New Window in Small Concession – It is the intention of the Board and Committee that a new window be installed before the 2007 season begins.

Asphalt – There was no asphalt work done in 2006, but we would like to complete the asphaltting around the main concession stand and around fields 6-8.

Bathrooms – Jena received a quote to gut the bathrooms and replace everything; it would cost about \$15,000 – replacing just the dividers is approximately \$1,000 per divider
