Complex Update

Handrails Dakota Steele has stated that handrails will be completed by 4/1/07. Installation has not yet begun, but Tim is keeping in close contact to make sure that they get installed.

Front Entrance – Water Main Break – now that there have been nicer days they will start to break up the concrete and turn the water on, from there they should be able to determine where the problem is and how to correct it.

New Window in Small Concession – Due to the death of Jay Mendle's wife last month, this project was put on hold, Jay plans to start work on the window next week, if the weather holds, and expects it to take a couple of days to complete. Warm weather is required so that the mortar can set properly.

Addition On Main Concession Stand – The electrical work has been completed, now there is just some cleaning to do and Debbie will be able to move coolers etc. in.

Bathrooms at the Small Concession Stand – The women's bathroom was constructed using plywood for partitions so that the facility would be ready for a tournament a few years back. We are currently waiting on a bid to see what it will cost to have actual partitions but up.

Registration Update– As of tonight there have been 30 – 35 registration forms turned in. Deadline in March 15.

Home Run Rule – At the State meeting in January the State changed the home run rule to the following:

Div. I – six runs

Div. II – three runs

Div. III – two runs

Div. IV – one run

After a lengthy discussion the Committee voted to change the local home run rules to follow State guidelines.

Stealing Rule – The Committee voted to change the stealing rule to the following:

At the time of the coin toss the umpire will ask both teams if they want to steal, if either team says “no” then there will be no stealing for that game and the umpire will write it on the back of the card. This new ruling applies to all men's divisions on all nights.

Rules & Regulation for 2007 – After making the above-mentioned changes, all rules were reviewed and approved by the Committee. Angie will forward them to Chuck Clark and Justin Amundson for umpire review, once they have reviewed them they will be posted on the website and a copy will be placed in each manager's packet to be handed out at the Spring meeting.
