Our meeting this month is very brief, Jena quickly discussed a few items that were discussed at last month's meeting.

Sports Complex Grants – At the last meeting we approved the following grant applications: Applications to build concrete retaining walls and install new concrete sidewalks where needed will be submitted this month. Each grant is for approximately \$24,999.00 and we will have two years to complete the projects.

Registration Update – 50 turned in.

Jena has received many inquiries this year from players wanting to know if they can play on two teams in Rapid City. The Committee decided that further discussion would be needed, but for the 2008 season we will continue to follow the ASA rules and each player will only be allowed to play on one RCSA team per season.

The Pepsi contract expires 12/31/08. We will be considering bids from Pepsi and Coke for the 2009 season and beyond.

Tim has started shooting the fields. They will also be resetting home plates, installing new foul poles, and removing the lips on each field. The new poles are 18' tall and will be in the ground about 2', they will be about 8' above the fences.

There will be no Men's or Women's softball after Men's State III & IV tournament as we will be preparing for the Co-ed season as it will start earlier this year.

A couple months ago we discussed the possibility of wooden bats in co-ed, this idea has been tabled as they are looking at the ball at a State level. We will await the outcome with great hopes.

The State voted to keep stealing out of Women's softball in South Dakota.

The price the Association pays for a dozen softballs dropped from \$39 to \$35 this year.

There will be a Roller Derby the Friday night of the King of the Hills tournament held in the parking lot behind field 4, as well as the home run derby on field 4
