► Numbers on the back of jerseys will be enforced.

► All league games may be played with (8) players. The injury rule does not apply when a team starts with 8 players...

► Player cards will be used.— The card checks in 2005 were very well

received and this helped all involved reduce the liability risk of non-registered players.
