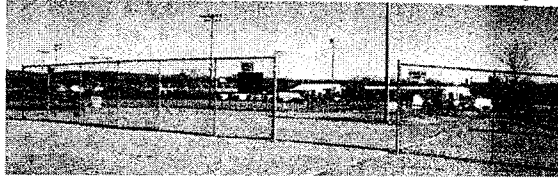

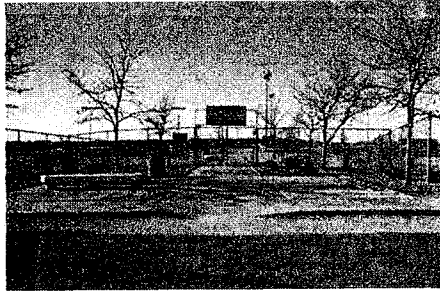

Warm-up Areas



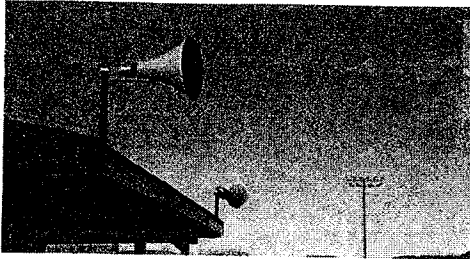
Re-Landscaped the main entrance.

New Public Announcement System was installed for the 2007 season—The National Anthem should be heard on all EIGHT fields, as well as all announcements.

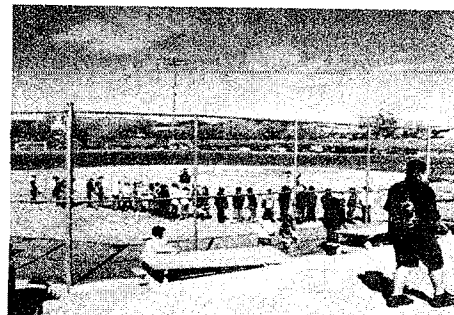
Season Reminders
